
NOTE: At this point it is a good idea to wear rubber gloves for the rest of the cleaning process.

With the print head out of the way you can gently push the wiper tray back to gain access to the blades. Using a soft cloth dampened with warm water, gently wipe and clean the vertical portions of the wiper blades. Inspect the blades carefully for any damage, such as nicks or cuts. Replace if necessary. (see Monthly section for wiper removal details)



Next push the wiper tray completely to the rear to gain access to the capping station plate.



Closely inspect the capping stations for any harden ink particles or chucks, carefully wipe away any debris using caution to not damage the rubber seal.

NOTE: DO NOT USE a sharp instrument to remove debris from capping plate as damage to the rubber seals may occur.
